District Profile

Today, the Standard School District has a student population of approximately 2,900 and encompasses an area of approximately 34 square miles. The district has three K-5 elementary schools and one 6-8-grade middle school in the North of the River area of metropolitan Bakersfield. The schools in the Standard School District are modern, functional facilities that are equipped with computers and other multimedia, and are staffed with excellent teachers and support staff.

Standard School District is located in Kern County, in northern Bakersfield. This is a part of a fast-growing metropolitan area. The district was formed on February 4, 1909. The area is primarily residential in nature with affordable housing development taking place. The major industry is oil production. There is considerable commercial and industrial development planned in this area.

The major airport, Meadows Field, is adjacent to the district, and is served by major airlines.

The location makes recreational and social activities easily accessible to those who enjoy mountains, desert, ocean, and the large city. Kern County is a mere 111 miles north of Los Angeles and less than a 2 hour drive from the beaches of the Pacific Ocean. Theater and symphony performances are regularly available. Numerous educational and cultural advantages are brought to the community by California State University, Bakersfield. Bakersfield College, a community college, is nearby and offers programs for students who desire to be close to home for their first year or two of college.
