Location

Located in the heart of the California's Salinas Valley, the City of Greenfield is approximately 135 miles south of San Francisco, 95 south of San Jose, and 60 miles north of Paso Robles. There are four interchanges that access the City of Greenfield from Highway 101 (El Camino Real, Oak St., Walnut St., and Thorne Rd.)

The City of Greenfield is located between the Gabilan mountain range to the east and the Santa Lucia range to the west. To the north, the City of Salinas acts as the major urban center for a number of rapidly growing communities along Highway 101. The communities to the north of Greenfield, include the Cities of Soledad and Gonzales, and to the south, the City of King City. All of these areas, including Greenfield have shown significant increases in population.
